JUBILEE YEAR 2025 WE ARE PILGRIMS OF HOPE

From the Gusset—Our Desert Path



As we go into **the desert** for these **40 days of Lent**, our Lord stands right next to us—our Lord wants to be **intimate** with us—just as any **lover** wants to be **intimate** with his **beloved**. Remember Jesus **loves** you, because His Father in Heaven **loves** you! God the Father has sent His Son to be **intimate** with you, to stand next to you for **40 days**, and to try to help you to see, to

recognize, what **the purpose of your life is**; and so our Lord comes up alongside of each one of us, and our Lord reaches into our **souls**—that most sacred of spaces, and Jesus starts to take things out of this **great cavernous space**, this **storage area**, this **sacred receptacle**. Jesus starts to take things out and discard them. These are things like food, **money**, and objects that we are fond of—these are things like pride, **possessions**, and power—these can even be harmful relationships, **comforts**, and past memories—Jesus starts to take these things out of the **receptacle** or the

container we call our **soul**—and the Lord says, "you don't really need this, **Fr. Randy**. I will just set this thing on **the desert** floor and make a little bit more room, a little bit more space, in your **soul**." Jesus says, "this thing has attached itself to you—it doesn't really belong in this **sacred space**, so I, the Lord, your God, I am just going to **detach** it from you, so that it doesn't **enslave** you." Some of the things that Jesus wants us to leave behind in **the desert**, some of these things we readily agree with Jesus: 'yes, I don't need that' or 'yes, I can see it is **harmful** to me' – 'please, Lord, take it away from me.' **But** then there are other things.... Things that **sin**, **the world**, and **Satan** have **convinced** us that we really need, and so when God tries to take them out of our **life**—when Jesus tries to get us to leave these things behind in **the desert**.—we object! 'Oh, no, Lord, don't take that from me this is something I **want** to attach myself to—I don't want to lose that thing, that thing **defines** who I am!' And this is where Jesus must tell us, "No, **Fr. Randy**, that is <u>not</u> who My Father **made** you to be. My Dad doesn't want you to be **defined** by this thing; rather, My Heavenly Father would like you to open up that **space in your soul**—that

this thing now occupies—and make room for something so much greater: My Love! See, Fr. Randy, I brought you into the desert for these 40 days to empty your soul of all this clutter and make a great space make your soul a worthy receptacle to pour all of My Love into. Allow Me, your Brother, the Son of Man, allow me, Jesus Christ—to lead you along the path to My Easter glory, where I will fill your heart to overflowing with My Love; and then, come Easter, you can love My Father as I love Him."

BE RECONCILED DAY: APRIL 9TH

I **love the definition** of **reconciliation** that to be **reconciled** to someone is to be **eyelash** to **eyelash** with them. To be **reconciled** to someone means that they see only what you see, and you see only what they see. When I have **reconciled** with someone – I have made them see that I am **sorry** for what I have done to them, and so I ask for their **forgiveness**. When someone has **reconciled** with me – they have made me see that they only wanted to give their **forgiveness** to me! When you are so close to someone that your **eyelashes** are touching their

eyelashes – the only thing in your field of view is the other person and the only thing in their field of view is you! **St. Paul** says, that the Christ came to **reconcile the world** to His Father. The Son of God did this by **reconciling the world** to Himself by **the blood** of His **Cross**. Come **eyelash** to **eyelash** with God on **Wednesday**, **April** 9th – don't miss this **great opportunity** to say you are sorry for having offended God's **love** for you by **sinning** against Him – don't miss this **great opportunity** to hear God say, *"I absolve you of your sins—now let My Son pour all of His love into you when you receive Holy Communion!"*




CEMETERY CLEANUP

THE MASS AND THE SAINTS/ VISIO DIVINA

Dante enjoys praying Evening Prayer with the other souls in Purgatory as the sun sets, and particularly – **Dante** likes praying **the Our Father** with other **sinners**, who are being purified for Heavenly glory. Just so, the priest stands before the Heavenly Bread (the Eucharist), and encourages all present to desire this Bread. St. Francis de Sales thought that even though in the Latin Mass – it was the priest, who spoke the Our Father Prayer – that we ought either out loud or in silence, but with great humility and devotion, repeat it word for word after our priest - as if we were repeating it after the Lord, Himself. There then follows (in the Mass) a Prayer called the **Embolism** – where **the priest** offers yet another prayer for the people's **sanctity**, which expounds on the final petition of the Our Father: "deliver us from evil." Then follows a period of silence in the Latin Mass, for was not our Lord silent (according to His flesh) as He rested in the tomb on Good Friday and Holy Saturday; yet, in Spirit our Lord was descending into Hell, to do battle with the strong man (Satan) – to bind him and distribute the spoils – the Lord was winning souls for His Father's Kingdom. (Luke 11:21-22) Our Lord, because the **priest** asks Him to be **lenient** with our **sins** against Him: past, present, and future – our Lord saves us from the (waterless) pit into which we (by our sins) flung the Christ. (Genesis 37:24, **Zechariah 9:11)** I just love the Resurrection Icon, which shows our Lord surf boarding down to Hell to bind Satan and loose the souls for Heavenly Glory. Notice to our Lord's left – how the three men: Abel, Abraham, and Melchizedek are arranged. Melchizedek looks to be like the mirror image of the Resurrected Christ. Indeed, our Father in Faith, Abraham, is the only person in the Icon looking not at Jesus or out at us (the viewer of the Icon), but Abraham looks at Melchizedek, because Melchizedek is that mysterious priest from Salem—himself 'a type' of



Christ! Just as Abraham was shocked to find out that he had met the Second Person of the Trinity, while still on **earth**; so I tell all **married couples**, you will be shocked at your **Particular Judgment** to find out that you also met the Second Person of the Trinity, while still on earth -whenever you looked upon your **spouse**! It should send a shiver down the spine of every married couple, when your priest prays the embolism prayer for you, your spouse, your children, and your children's children - that your **priest** is making our Lord promise that He will save you from the waterless pit - that Jesus promises again what He promised each of us at our **Baptisms** – that we should never know **death**, but live with His Father in glory!
