Wouldn't that be something, if our Country could love as generously as God loves!?! As our Bishop and all the Bishops of the Land work to consecrate our Country to the Sacred Heart, Fr. Randy will celebrate a Novena of Masses to help we, as individuals, to consecrate ourselves to the Lord's Sacred Heart.

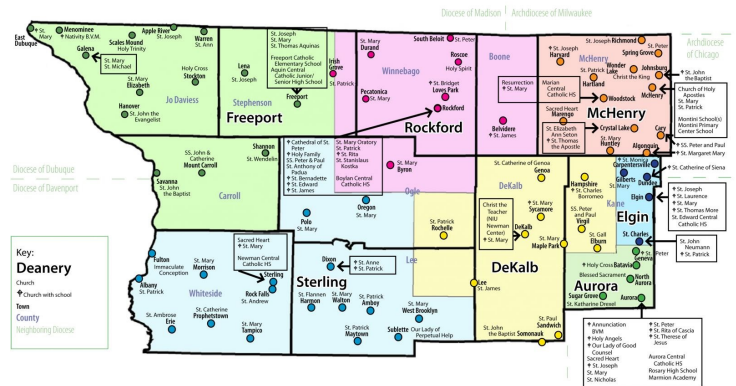

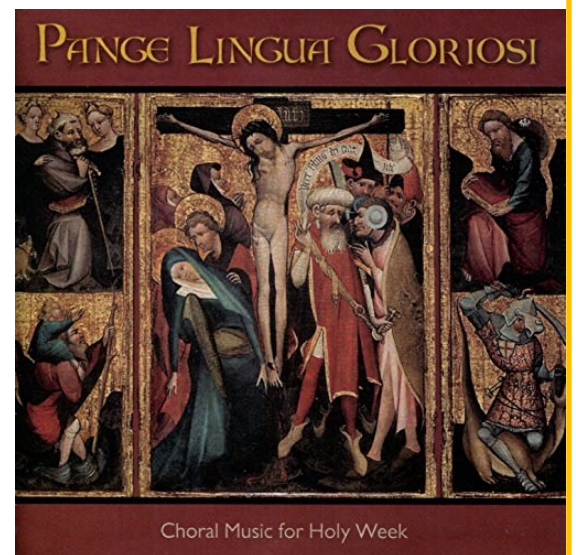
- 1) Receive **the Eucharist** on **Corpus Christi** Sunday

- 5) Walk in **Procession** behind our **Eucharistic Lord**\*

\*Note: If because of age or disability one cannot enter **the Procession** an **Indulgence** can still be obtained, if you remain in the Church for **the Solemn Benediction Prayers**.

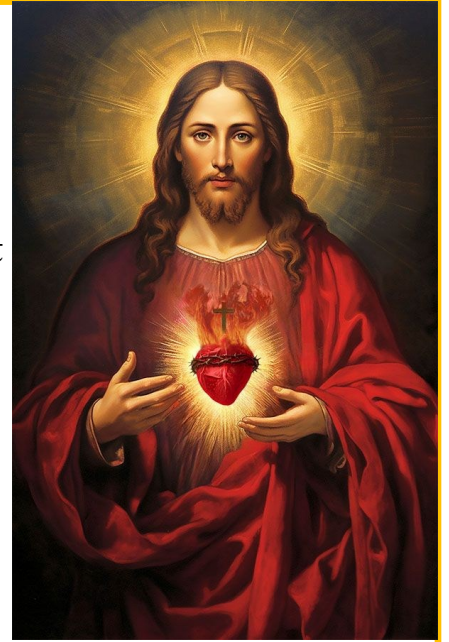
